1. **Old & New terminology**

- i. The new
 - The new being the second and the first becoming old by way of the new
 - Examples
 1. World - 2 Pet. 2:5

2. Heavens & Earth - 2 Pet. 3:5, 10-13
3. Testament & Covenant - Heb. 8:13, {Heb. 9, 10:1-9}

ii. The new man

- The truth that is in Jesus (the truth that is in Adam)
- Jesus Christ taking on flesh as God, defeating sin and death, and paying for our sin debt, then rising from the dead brings in the new man that we may be identified with Christ

2. The Old & New MAN

- Romans 5:11-21; 1 Cor. 15:45-47 (last, second)
- Eph. 2:10, Col. 2:10-12, 3:1-11 - workmanship, operation

2. The Conversation

- The old and new man have a conversation
- **Conversation** - mid-14c., "place where one lives or dwells," also "general course of actions or habits, manner of conducting oneself in the world," both senses now obsolete
 - "place where one lives and dwells" - Php. 3:20, Col. 3:1-3
 - "general course of actions or habits, manner of conducting oneself in the world" - Eph. 4, Eph. 2
- Rom. 6:1-23

3. Put Off - Put On

- Past and continuing tense
- The old man was us in Adam and we added to that a consistent conversation, fitting and suitable to the one that plunge us into bondage.
- The new man is us in Christ and we are to add to that a consistent conversation, fitting and suitable to the one that delivered and gave us freedom.
- Thus the Holy Ghost not only regenerates us, but renews that which is regenerated - all things are new
 - Col. 3:9-10
 - Old man with his deeds
 - New man with his deeds
- The renewing is consistent to the regeneration.
 - We have put off the old man and its former conversation - corrupt according to the deceitful lusts
 - We have put on the new man and be renewed in the spirit of our mind concerning this - created in righteousness and true holiness
- Rom. 13:12 - "cast off the works of darkness" {:13ff}
- Eph. 4:25 - "putting away lying"

- Col. 3;8 - "put off all these; anger, wrath, malice..."

2. Renewing

**And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
{Ephesians 4:23}**

- **"And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;" - Rom. 12:1-3**
 - Concerning the old and new and the activity of them
 - Deny & Live
 - Put off & Put on
 - Be not & Be

**And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true
holiness.
{Ephesians 4:24}**

- **"which after God is created"** - God is the creator of this new creature
 - Non-existent before - none righteous, no not one, none that doeth good, no not one
- **"in righteousness and true holiness"** - imputed righteousness, fruits of righteousness, zealous of good works, careful to maintain good works, unto good works
