## Lesson 2: Apparent Contradictions

## - APPARENT CONTRADICTIONS

- Example: If I told you today we should build an ark in order to follow God, would I be right in telling you that or not? NO! Why? I am being Biblical I could go back to Genesis 6:14 and say well Noah was a person of God, we are the people of God; "Make God an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch....etc". God gave a command to do that and we are to follow the commandments of God and if you didn't you would be disobeying God. I could be totally Biblical and Scriptural in saying that, but why would I be wrong?
- Context, not what God is doing today (what determines what God is doing today or not), His Word

## Terminology

- 2 Timothy 2:15-"rightly dividing" (by going through those contradictions are starting to notice two teachings)
- Scriptures broken down (Gen. - Acts 7 \& Heb. - Rev. vs. Rom. - Phe.)
- When you divide something you at least have 2 of something.
- They are similar, but different and each together make up the whole.
- How is one not ashamed, according to this verse? By study and being a workman
- How does the workman work? By "rightly dividing the word of truth"
- Therefore, we know something

1. This is going to take some work in the field of study
a) Study - a setting of the mind or thoughts upon a subject; to apply the mind to; to read and examine for the purpose of learning and understanding
b) The subject of study is "the word of truth" and how we study and how we work in studying is by "rightly dividing the word of truth".
c) If we don't disastrous results will follow; overthrown and overthrow regarding faith (v. 16-18)
2. There is at least 2 parts when we divide (need to look for)
a) 2 distinct parts
3. If Paul commands us to do it, then he must be doing it

## - 3 Primary Ways of Learning

1. Following along and paying attention from Genesis to Paul one ought to see where the division needs to be made.

- The apostle Paul teaches this in 2 primary places

2. Romans 9-11
3. Eph. 2-3

- Romans 9-11 --- (In a sense are learning it backwards)
- Romans 9-11 is the first time in Paul's epistles where he goes into detail regarding Israel and his ministry.

## 1) Apostleship

- An apostle
- God already had 12 (Matt. 19:28)
- Common misunderstandings
- Paul is the 12th apostle and Judas' replacement
- Paul is the 13th apostle
- Paul is not Judas' replacement, Matthias was; therefore he is not one of the 12 or the 13th apostle as if he preached the same message
i. Acts 2, 3; 1 Cor. 15
ii. Holy Spirit confirmed
iii. Regulations (Paul did not meet)

2) Message

- Did Paul preach the same message as the 12 ?
- Galatians 1, 2; Matt. 3, 10 (message \& gospel being preached)
- Luke 18:31-34 (Cross)
- Acts 2
