{2 Timothy 3:1} This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

- "This know also,"
  - o 2 Timothy 2:22-26
  - Doesn't mince words
- "that in the last days perilous times shall come."
  - o Romans 8:35 Adversaries tactics
  - o 2 Corinthians 11:25-28
  - o "last days"
    - After Paul's death
  - "perilous times shall come"
    - Times defined by peril
      - □ Dangerous; hazardous; full of risk; dreadful; terrible
      - □ Particular exposure of person or property to injury, loss or destruction from any cause whatever

{2 Timothy 3:2} For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

- "for men"
  - Within and without
- "shall be lovers of their own selves"
  - Matters of the heart
    - Not economic issues
    - Issues of war
  - o "covetous" -
  - o "boasters"
  - o "proud"
  - o "blasphemers"
  - o "disobedient to parents"
  - o "unthankful"
  - o "unholy"

# {2 Timothy 3:3} Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

- "without natural affection"
- o "trucebreakers"
- o "false accusers"
- o "incontinent"
- o "fierce"
- o "despisers of those that are good"

# {2 Timothy 3:4} Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

- o "traitors"
- o "heady"
- o "highminded"
- "lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;"

# {2 Timothy 3:5} Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

- "having a form of godliness"
  - 1 Timothy 6:20 "keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:"
    - Philosophy
    - Psychology
    - Political Science
    - Systems
    - Systems of Theory
    - Secular Humanism
    - The American Constitutionalism
  - Form of thinking, a form of conduct, a form working

- Better humanity
- Isa. 5:20-25
- "but denying the power thereof:"
  - The power of godliness
    - The Word of God, the Sword of the Spirit
  - o Do so in measure
    - World and the church

### **Resisters of Truth**

{2 Timothy 3:6} For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,

- "For of this sort"
  - o A form of godliness, but don't have the power
- "are they which creep into houses,"
  - To move with the belly on the ground; to move secretly
  - Come into the church
    - Acts 20:28-32
- "and lead captive silly women"
  - o 2 Tim. 2:26
  - "silly women" men and women that will believe superstition, visions, dreams, surmisings, fables, conspiracies "gain is godliness"
    - Weak in intellect; foolish; witless; destitute of ordinary strength of mind
  - o "laden with sins"
    - To put on as a burden
    - Entangleth himself with the affairs of this life
    - Unlawful striving of reward
    - Striving about words
    - Vessels of wood and earth
  - o "led away with divers lusts,"
    - Other pursuits than godliness

{2 Timothy 3:7} Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

- "ever learning"
  - Learning the sciences

- They learn the forms of godliness
- Rom. 16:19 become simple concerning good and wise concerning evil
- "and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth."
  - Forsake the truth in their learning
  - o Forsake the truth in their thinking
  - Forsake the truth in their living
    - 1 Tim. 4:6-16

{2 Timothy 3:8} Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

- "Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses"
  - Their form of godliness without power (appearance of power)
  - Contrast to godliness with power
- "so do these also resist the truth"
  - o Withstand
  - o To act in opposition
- "men of corrupt minds"
  - Mind earthly things
- "reprobate concerning the faith."
  - Not enduring proof or trail (sucked up into this)
  - Do not purge themselves

{2 Timothy 3:9} But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was.

- "But they shall proceed no further:"
  - The sound of that which is temporary
  - Does not have the sound of eternity
- "for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was."
  - o Now or at the judgment seat of Christ
  - Judgment day

# **Heralders of Truth**

{2 Timothy 3:10} But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience,

- "my doctrine"
- "manner of life"
- "purpose"
- "faith"
- "longsuffering"
- "charity"
- "patience"

{2 Timothy 3:11} Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me.

- "persecutions"
- "afflictions"
  - o Antioch, Iconium, Lystra
- "I endured"
  - o "but out of them all the Lord delivered me."

{2 Timothy 3:12} Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

{2 Timothy 3:13} But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

- "evil men"
- "seducers"
  - o "wax worse and worse"
  - o "deceiving"
  - o "and being deceived."
