**Behold Israel after the flesh: are not they which eat of the sacrifices partakers of the altar?  
{1Co 10:18}**

## **2. Israel After the Flesh**

2.1 - "Behold Israel after the flesh:" - old testament

2.2 - "are not they which eat of the sacrifices"

2.2.1 - eat of those sacrifices - eat of the sacrifice of Christ

1. Justification

2. Daily walk

2.3 - "partakers of the altar?"

2.3.1 - sanctified - they are partakers of the altar - distinct from the Gentiles that did so to devils

**What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is any thing?  
{1Co 10:19}**

2.4 - "What say I then?"

2.4.1 - "that the idol is any thing?" - no - 1 Cor. 8:4

2.4.2 - "or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is any thing?" - no - 1 Cor. 8:8

**But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils.  
{1Co 10:20}**

2.5 - "But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God:"

2.5.1 - Deut. 32:1-21 (:17)

2.6 - "and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils."

2.6.1 - the main issue - what's wrong with fellowship with devils? (don't know your King)

1. God does not have fellowship with devils

2. 2 Cor. 6:14-18 - "unequal yoke"

**Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.  
{1Co 10:21}**

## **3. The Lord of the Table - The Lord's Table - The Lord of the Body**

3.1 - "Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils:"

3.1.1 - Cup of the Lord - drink into one Spirit (1 Cor. 12; Eph. 5 - filled with the Spirit)

3.1.2 - Contrast between the wisdom of the world, spirit of the world, and the wisdom of God and the spirit of God

3.2 - "ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and the table of devils."

2.8.1 - partakers in the fellowship of the Lord and the fellowship of devils

2.8.2 - He is the Lord of the table, He furnished it

2.8.3 - Rom. 14:8-9 - Lord both of the dead and living

**Do we provoke the Lord to jealousy? are we stronger than he?  
{1Co 10:22}**

3.3 - "Do we provoke the Lord to jealousy?"

3.3.1 - provoking of Israel (provoked the Lord) - Deut. 32

3.4 - "are we stronger than he?"

3.4.1 - cannot be stronger than Him

3.4.2 - {Pro 6:27} Can a man take fire in his bosom, and his clothes not be burned?

- {Pro 6:28} Can one go upon hot coals, and his feet not be burned?
