I. Intro/Review:

- We have considered the contrast between the Corinthians and Paul.
 - The Corinthians clave to the riches of this world they elevated them above the wisdom of God and compromised in their Christianity
 - Their Christianity didn't look or sound much different than the world, culture, and society around them
 - Paul describes an holy Christ, His holy work, the holy gospel, and the holy living it is designed to produced
- The Corinthians pursuit was cultural ascendency to attain and apprehend that which the world seeks after
 - Full, rich, reign as kings
- Paul and those with him were "appointed to death" a spectacle to the world: men and angels

Even unto this present hour we both hunger, and thirst, and are naked, and are buffeted, and have no certain dwellingplace; and labour, working with our own hands: being reviled we bless; being persecuted, we suffer it: being defamed, we intreat: we are made as the filth of the world, and are the offscouring of all things unto this day."

Description & Definition

- Suffering are hardships and difficulties experienced from situations and circumstances upon your flesh or soul.
 - Lack of rest in your flesh (2 Cor. 7:5)
 - Lack of rest in your spirit (2 Cor. 2:13)
- Suffering can be relative to that which you value, think you deserve or that which is owed you
 - Who has first given to Him that He should recompense? (Rom. 11)
