 - Two major ends (prompt)
 - ① End of the world
 - ② End of death

- ① The End of the world
 - Matt. 24: 3, 6, 13 (Dan. 2: 44)
 - 29 - sign

- ② The End of Death (keys - Rev. 1:18) (pwrpt)
 - 1 Cor. 15:22-28
 - Rev. 20:13-14 (Rev. 20:2-7) thousand years (pwrpt)

• The end of prophecy is God's kingdom through His Son established on earth with all things restituted & reconciled for His glory

- Rev. 11:15 (DAN 2:44) (expected end - Jer. 29:11, 31:17)
 - "the kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of His Christ"
 - All power (post resurrection - MAT. 28:18)
 - Kingdoms given (PS 2:1-8 (:92))
 - Kingdoms destroyed (DAN. 2:44)
 - Kingdoms preserved (MAT. 25:31A)

 - ↳ greatness (greatness)
 - the mystery of His greatness (Eph. 1)

 - wickedness, destruction, strange woman

- ACTS 3:19-21
 - refreshing (presence)
 - restitution (70th wk, 1,000 yrs)
 - dealing with all enemies
