

I CORINTHIANS ("LABORERS WITH GOD") | 1 Cor. 3:5-9 | LESSON 43

③ INTRO/REVIEW:

- Paul doesn't speak the meat to the Corinthians because of their inability to bear it
- The cause of their inability — their love of the carnal
- "I am of" — denotes some excellency to the individual and that which the individual communicates
- "I am of Paul" > examines some human, fleshly, carnal feature to identify w/
"I am of Apollos" • wise, mighty, noble (just like the world)

④ PREVIEW:

- Laborers with God
 - Reproof (:5a)
 - Correction (:5b-9)
 - Last. of Rte (:10-17)

⑤ SERMON:

[:5] - "who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man?"

- The Corinthians need to understand God is behind these men and not the men themselves nor the talents and gifts they may possess.
- Paul is constantly humbling himself in argument → the opposite of what many Pastors/Teachers do.

- BESTIMES
- { ① Some gift, some ability to give credibility
 - ② Some vision from God to give credibility to give you a sense you're doing the Lord's work
 - ③ Some manifestation of blessing (prosperity),
 - ④ Some exploiting of the desires of the flesh

- nothing in Paul & Apollos inherently (Phi. 3) (Gal. 1:13-17)
 - nothing of special recognition that God needs

• "but ministers by whom ye believed" [4:15, 9:1-15, 11:1]

- ① both are included

• not just gospel, but more

- ② ministers must have or been given something to minister

③ "ye believed" - faith comes by hearing the word of God
 [1 Thes. 2:13]

• "even as the Lord gave to every man?"

① The Lord gave men

② The Lord gave those men what they were to minister

③ "every man"

• does not allow for ownership

The Lord owns and is operating

[1:6] - "I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase."

① :5 - ① Lord gives substance to ministers

② Lord gives ministers to every man

③ Ministers minister God gives the increase

② Illustration of garden, agriculture

(2 Cor. 9:10ff.)

• "husbandry", "husbandmen"

• 10-17 = building illustration

• growth, development

• "increase" = grow
