Hold Fast - form of sound words

{2 Timothy 1:13} Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

• "hold fast" - in possession of the mind; to cling

• "the form of sound words"

- Sound words
- Sound doctrine
- Sound mine
- "form" pattern (1 Tim. 1:16)
- "sound" wholesome (1 Tim. 6:3)
 - 2 Tim. 4:3
 - Tit. 1:9

- Be not ashamed of Christ
 - Nor of me His prisoner

- :10 Christ
 - :11 Paul
- Stir up based upon "spirit" given

Keep Gift

{2 Timothy 1:14} That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.

- "that good thing" spirit/words/testimony of our Lord
- "which was committed unto thee" :6 (putting on of my hands)
- "keep" hold fast
 - "by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us" :8 (according to the power of God)

Examples

{2 Timothy 1:15} This thou knowest, that all they which are in Asia be turned away from me; of whom are Phygellus and Hermogenes.

- "This thou knowest" (:18)
 - "persuade"
- "that all they which are in Asia be turned away from me"
 - "of whom are Phygellus and Hermogenes."
 - Leaders

{2 Timothy 1:16-18} The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain: But, when he was in Rome, he sought me out very diligently, and found me. The Lord grant unto him that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day: and in how many things he ministered unto me at Ephesus, thou knowest very well.

- "The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus"
 - $\circ~:\!18$ "The Lord grant unto him that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day"
 - Matt. 5:7, 9:13/12:7, 23:23
 - Origin
 - "house of Onesiphorus" Paul's ministry (:11)
 - Onesiphorus actions
 - Generated from :7-10
 - "oft refreshed me"
 - "was not ashamed of my chain"

- "sought me out very diligently, and found me"
 "how many things he ministered unto me"
- "thou knowest very well."
