  - Definition "ekklesia" {translated "church" (115x); "assembly" (3x)}
    - Gathering of people called out (assembly)
  - The Church of God (1 Cor. 1:2; 10:32, 11:22)
    - Those called out by God to assemble
    - Acts 20:28 purchased with His own blood
    - Church of God Prior to Paul (primarily Jews Matt. 10)
      - Church of God that Paul persecuted Gal. 1:13
      - Christ's church Matt. 16:18

- "Rock" (foundation) Jesus is the Christ
- Christ's church (built) added to Acts 2:47
- Christ's church "spiritual house" 1 Pet. 2:1-10
- Earthly Election
- Church of God After Paul (Gentiles and Jews Acts 9:15-16
  - Christ's church Eph. 1:22-23
    - "Foundation" 1 Cor. 3; Eph. 2:20
  - Christ's church added to Eph. 2:22

#### • The Body of Christ

- Christ the foundation
- Purchased with His blood
- Made up of believing Jews and Gentiles
- Baptized by one Spirit into one body where there is no Jew or Gentile
- Macro-structure big picture
  - 1. Head Eph. 4:15-16 Christ is the head of the church the church is His body
  - 2. Body 1 Cor. 12:12-14 one body made up of many members
- Micro-structure small picture
  - Body made up of many members
  - 1. **Authority** 1 Tim. 3:1-5 those that take care of the church of God
    - Acts 20:28 overseers (undershepherds)
    - 1 The. 5:12 labour among you, over you in the Lord
      - Labor 1 Tim. 5:17-18 word and doctrine
  - 2. Members Rom. 12:4-5 many members
    - Those under
    - Have an office

#### Roles

  - 1. Labor in word and doctrine
  - 2. Rule from that labor
    - Judgments wise men and men of understanding (governments, helps)

- Edifying of the body of Christ (Christ-efficiency within each member)
