The Spiritual Gifts

- Diversities of Gifts
 - The gifts are the means by which to administer something
- Diversities of Administrations
 - The administrations carry out the operations of God
- Diversities of Operations
 - The operations are various functions and capacities the church and the members of it are to labor in.

The More Excellent Way

- 1 Corinthians 12:31
 - o "yet shew I unto you a more excellent way"
 - The Corinthians had turned the last gift and treated it as the best gift
 - Paul has shared the hierarchy of the spiritual gifts, as well as, that each gift has a purpose or operation that God has for it to fulfill.
 - o "more excellent" two superlatives hyperbolic expression of praise
 - Now, Paul is going to teach them the most excellent ministry of the Holy Ghost that they should be concerned about and if they are not and if they are not partaking in it, then they are nothing.
 - o Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-13
 - "tongues of men and of angels"
 - ☐ This is the Corinthians focus "tongues"
 - ☐ Yet, if Paul or they do and has not charity they become nothing.
 - "the gift of prophecy"
 - $\hfill\square$ "understand all mysteries, and all knowledge, and though I have all faith"
 - "I am nothing"
 - "bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned"
 - □ "and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing"
- Romans 5:5
 - "love of God is shed abroad in our hearts"
 - You can't love like God does, until you know how God loves you
 - It is the basis in which you love other members of the body of Christ and all men
- Romans 12:3
 - Our Father begins to teach us how to love our neighbor (believers & unbelievers) as ourselves.
