• The question asked in Romans given an answer

① "who" = natural man

② "that he" - natural man

③ "may instruct him" - spiritual man

④ "we have the mind of Christ" - to instruct the natural

• What does that mean?

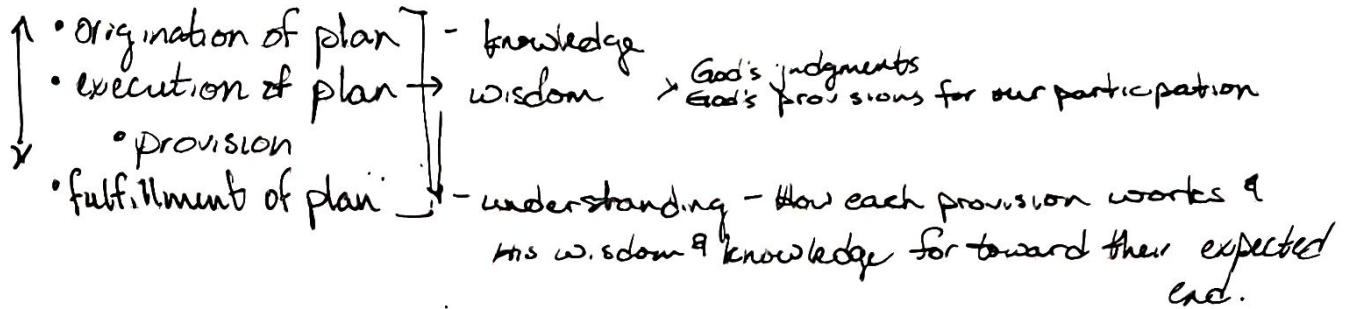

• "the mind of Christ"

• consist of the reasoning & purpose for all things, God's power to work all things to its fulfillment & provision for all those involved to take part in His things.

 - spiritually discerned

Discern

→ 1 Cor. 9:3

- examined (Luke 23:14, Acts 4:9, 28:9)
- searched (Acts 17:11)
- judgeth (1 Cor. 2:15, 4:4, 14:24)

:15 - spiritual man

- :12 - not only receive (possession)
 - Rom. 8:4
 - 1 The 2:13
- not foolish
- Spiritual judgeth
 - discern
- yet he himself is judged of no man

receive - accept

comparing
discerned
judge
instructed

Comparing - to judge one thing in connection with another

- things of Spirit are spiritually discerned

need to accept to discern, to know

discerned - to separate with the eye

- to see the difference

God is Judge
Rom. 14

judgeth → investigate, search, examine, judge

discern all things

↳ looking at everything spiritually (spiritual discernment)

- takes what Spirit gives & uses it

judged of no man

↳ how can a man judged you w/o the Spirit

judge you & judge they are better
"of"

Explanation of a man judging you w/o the mind of the lord, *unequal yoke (2 Cor. 6)*

means
in the same mind
in the same judgment

- instruct (prong, assuredly, gathering, compacted (Eph. 4:16), knit together (Col. 2:2) 9)
- to teach; to inform the mind (to furnish)

Judgment

- (indicative)
- knowledge - clear/certain perception of the which is (truth)
 - wisdom - right use or exercise of knowledge (practice - discerning & judging, just, proper, useful)
 - understanding - not simply to apprehend the reality of things
- landable ends
- deliber from evil man & strange woman
