- The Unfulfilled Conquest | History
  1. God Judges the Nations | Tower of Babel | Gen. 11
  2. God Promises to Abram | Great Nation, Land, Blessing to World | Gen. 12
    - Heb. 11:8-10 (Gen. 12:6ff, 20 | Canaan, Egypt, near Sodom and Gomorrah, Gerar)
    - If it took place with Abraham, why promised in the law
      - Ex. 19:5-6, Deut. 28:13, 44
    - God speaks of another day to Abram - Gen. 15:13-14
  3. God Establishes Nation & Moses | Ex. 1:7 and Exodus
    - Moses Last Acts | Israel and latter days - Deut. 30:15-18, 31:24-30, 32:29
    - Moses & Joshua | Deut. 31:7, 14-15, 32:44, 34:9
  4. God & the Conquest of Joshua | Joshua 1:1-11 (transition from Moses into the Land)
    - Heb. 4:8 - "Jesus" = Joshua - implication Joshua gave them not rest
      - David - Ps. 95:1-11 (:7-8)
      - Israel still not at "rest"
      - The writer of Hebrews in 4:11 explains they "labour therefore to enter into that rest"
      - Heb. 11:39-40 - "And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise: God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect."
    - Joshua's Failed Conquest
      - Isn't that he didn't defeat many of Israel's and God's enemies - God did
      - Is that Israel heart still isn't changed
    - Conquest Little-by-Little
      - Preparation for the conquest

- Deut. 7:1, :22 - little by little
  - Deut. 7:1-26
  - Drive Out - Ps. 20:7
    - Joshua 17:16-18 - "chariots of iron"
  - Joshua 23:1-16 - God will drive them out if you obey, He will not if you disobey
    - If you desire to serve other Gods
  - Joshua 24:1-28 - recap history and Joshua calls them to witness where they are (apple doesn't fall from the tree - generation just like their parents)
    - :14 - now fear the Lord (not enemies)
    - :19-21 - serve the God ONLY
    - :26 - reminder of Pharaoh's "chariots"
  - Could Not | Chariots of Iron
    - Judges 1:19, 4:3 (Barak) - chariots of iron
    - Joshua 17:12
    - Joshua 7:12 - lesson from the past
  - Israel will not have rest, nor drive out enemies, nor possess their land, or be a great nation without God, thus their idolatry God will judge by not giving them these promises.
5. Jesus Christ and Another Day - 2 The. 1:3-10 (He is worthy - vengeance is His - just and true)
- The Day of the Lord
  - Matt. 3:2, 4:23 (Heb. 6:1-5)
  - Day of the Lord is at the end of the world
  - Day of the Lord - Ezekiel 21:27
    1. Ezekiel 21:26 - gives up Israel (1st installment)
    2. Overturn, overturn, overturn (2-4 installments)
    3. In the 3 installment Christ earns the right
    4. Kingdom - "I will give it Him"
      - Daniel 7:13-14
      - Rev. 4-5
      - Rev. 6 - open the book!
      - More overturning, has the right, preparation to give (Ps. 2)
      - Rev. 12:1-12 - (:10)
      - Rev. 19:1ff (:10-20 - Matt. 24 & Luke 21)
      - Rev. 20:1ff = Dan. 7:13-14
