  - 1) Under terror, consumption, and the burning ague
    - Effect
      - 1. Consume the eyes
      - 2. Cause sorrow of heart
    - Means
      - 1. God I will set my face against you
      - 2. Enemies
        - 1. Sow your seed in vain for enemies shall eat it
        - 2. Slain before enemies
        - 3. Those that reign over you will hate you
        - 4. Flee when none pursue
- 2. :18-20 (\*\*\*Marked with agricultural loss\*\*\*)
  - □ "yet"
  - □ "punish you seven times more for your sins"
  - 1) I will break the pride of your power
  - 2) I will make **your** heaven as iron and **your** earth as brass
    - ◆ Matt. 5:6; Acts 14:14-18
    - ◆ Effect
      - i) Your strength shall be spent in vain
        - "for your land shall not yield her increase"
        - "neither shall the trees of the land yield their fruits."
        - Isaiah 51:3 Eden
        - Ezekiel 36:35 Eden
        - Revelation 22:1-2 kingdom
- 3. <u>:21-22</u> (\*\*\*Marked by those man has dominion over exerting dominion over man\*\*\*)
  - "walk contrary"
  - "I will bring seven times more plagues upon you according to your sins"
    - Ex. 15:26 "...if...I will put none of these diseases upon thee"
    - Isa. 1:1-9, 30:26
    - Jer. 19:8, 49:17, 50:13
    - Zech. 14:12, 15, 18
      - Jer. 30:17
      - Hosea 13:14
  - 1) "I will also send wild beasts among you"
    - Effect
      - 1. "Which shall rob you of your children" ("make you few in number" Deut. 4:27, 7:7, 28:62)

- 2. "destroy your cattle"
- 3. "highways desolate
- 4. <u>:23-26</u>
- 5. <u>:27-39</u>
- Israel's Sought out Response Leviticus 26:40-41
  - 1) "if they confess their iniquity, and iniquity of their fathers"
    - "with their trespasses which they trespassed against me, and"
    - "that also they have walked contrary unto me" (:21 3rd course of punishment)
  - 2) "if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled"
  - 3) "and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:"
