① The Fellowship of the Saints

- [:9] - "do they diligence to come shortly unto me"

(:21) - do they diligence to come before winter

- Paul was not a one man show. As much as God had given ~~to~~ him, he understood the necessity for it and sought the WoG and fellowship w/others.

• Examples

Refreshed • Rom. 1:12; 15:32; 1 Cor. 16:18; 2 Tim. 1:16; Phil. 1:7

Fellowship • 1 Cor. 1:9-10; Php. 1:5, 2:1 (Jn. 1:3, 7)

• [:10-12] - Situation that makes Paul alone & isolated

- ① Paul not afraid to say come here (mutual understanding of inconvenience)

② Demas forsook Paul

③ loved this present world

④ Seemingly a common experience

⑤ departed to Thessalonica

③ Crescents to Galatia

⑥ Titus to Dalmatia

• only Luke is w/me

• bring Mark

⑦ he is profitable for me for the ministry

• Tychicus sent to Ephesus

↳ bringing this to Timothy

② The Word of God

• Paul not only benefitted greatly from fellowship but also from, of course, the word of God

① The Truth - (W_oG)

② The Pillar & Ground of the Truth - (The Church)

• [13] - "...and the books, but especially the parchments"

• books - papyrus scrolls (possibly OT books)

• "parchments" - vellum sheets made of treated animal hides

- extremely expensive

• Copies of his letters - implication when arrested he had no opportunity to get them (Timothy got here w/diligence)

• W_oG in Paul's latter life

(3) Suffering & Endurance in View of Purpose

① Alexander

- much evil
- • hard reward him (Isaiah 12:1b; Rom. 12:16; 1 Pet 2:23)
- be ware
- greatly withstand our words

② Paul's loneliness (:16)

- rejection
- Paul's love

[::17] not forsaken

- Lord stood w/me
- strengthened me (Php. 4)
- Purpose → preaching might be fully known ((or-1))
 - Gentiles hear
 - delivered out of the mouth of the lion

(Rom. 8) 'the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work' Eph. 1 (heavenly places)

'preserve me to His heavenly kingdom'

(to whom be glory for ever and ever)
