- <u>Faith alone response</u>
- Paul given the revelation of Jesus Christ
 - Things witnessed concerning the new testament

- Fulness of Christ
- A dispensation of it was not witnessed to:
 - The means in which to have a dispensation of it, He must reconcile the world
 - Dispensational judgment to change the status of the world to not impute trespasses against them (Rom. 5, 11, 2 Cor. 5)

• Developing the Mystery

- This Mystery (Romans 11:25)
 - Not describing justification/salvation, nor it going to the Gentiles, but the context and the unexpected, unprophesied manner in which it went to the Gentiles
 - Partakers of Israel's spiritual things
- The Preaching of Jesus Christ according to the revelation of the mystery (Romans 16:25)
 - The Mystery of the Gospel
 - The Mystery of the Faith
 - The Mystery of Godliness
 - Take Jesus Christ regarding the gospel of God witnessed, manifest Him through Israel's fall for the purpose that those that would henceforth believe would do in connection with His purpose.
- The Mystery of Christ (Ephesians 3:1)
 - Sets forth the further details that based upon "this mystery" and "the revelation of the mystery" that God will be able fulfill the "mystery of His will", the mystery of Christ
 - □ A Mystery our resurrection
 - □ The Mystery of Iniquity our resurrection
