I PREVIEW/INTRO:

- ① See Propst → nations Israel would be among all come from Babel
- ② Tower of Babel = veil spread over the nations (idolatry)
 - darkness produced in rejection of God, ascribing glory, worship, & service to that which is not God
 - darkness that led to easy justification of their sin and ungodliness

III LESSON:

- ~~ISA~~ 25:6-8 → Ps 63:5 (Pro. 3:8) - health, strength
 - 6 - "feast of fat things" (full of marrow) - so relishing, so nourishing
 - ↳ "feast of wines on the lees" (well refined) - strongest-bodied wines
 - kept long on the lees (form of aging)
 - yeast in the wine begins to break down & release tiny amounts of sugars
 - the presence of these compounds is sensed by the tongue as a textural weightiness or increased body in the wine.
 - wine on the lees is described as creamier, richer, fuller-bodied, with greater depth
 - if the lees are stirred and not settled to increase their contact ~~surface~~ area
 - "Marriage Supper of the Lamb" -
 - 7 - Destruction of veil
 - ↳ counterfeit table
 - ↳ Rev 18:3 - wine of her wrath
 - "delicacies"
 - ↳ Rev. 19:1ff
 - 8 - rebuke of people taken away
 - sin, but also the law
- (sin → veil → the law) all death with

• Covenant of Promise

- "Covenant" - an agreement of two or more
↳ terms of agreement

- "promise" - written or verbal declaration made by one person to another which binds the person who made it to whom it is declared to

• verbal & written declaration (the word of God)

• timelessness

- two ^{mutability (negative)} immutable (invariableness, unalterable, cannot lie)
- Thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies

• test of Abraham's faith, not of God's promise

• Abraham was going to obtain.

• Yet, the promiser chooses when to deliver

• Therefore, patient endurance was needed to obtain
