- Ruth 4:4, 6
  - Sympathetic & Willing - Ruth 2:5-10, 3:11
  - Nearest Kinsman - Ruth 3:12
  - Able - Ruth 4:3
  - Able without Compromise - Ruth 4:5-6
- Laws of Redemption
  - Leviticus 25:23-55
- Isa. 41:14 - "Fear not, thou worm Jacob, and ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the Holy One of Israel."
- Isa. 44:24 - "Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and He that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;"
- Isa. 48:17 - "Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go."
- Isa. 49:7 - "Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee."

- Isa. 49:26 - "And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD am thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob."
- Isa. 54:5 - "For thy Maker is thine husband; the LORD of hosts is His name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall He be called."
- Isa. 59:20 - "And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD."
  - Rom. 11:26 - "And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, 'There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:'"
- Isa. 60:16

#### 4. **1 Samuel - King**

- Foreknowledge of King - Deut. 17:14-20
  - Judges 17:6, 18:1, 19:1, 21:25 - "there was no king in Israel"
  - 1 Samuel 8:1-22 - the people want a king
  - 1 Samuel 9:2 - Saul - (from 1 Sam. 9 to the end (chapter 3) Saul is king)

#### 5. **1st Set of Curses - Curse-Taker & Blessor**

- Deut. 27:16ff (Deut. 28; Lev. 26)
- Deut. 21:22-23 - "And if a man have committed a sin worthy of death, and he be to be put to death, and thou hang him on a tree: his body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; (for he that is hanged is accursed of God;) that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance."
  - Galatians 3:10-14
  - Isa. 53:1ff
- Blessor by Judge & King
  - John's gospel
  - King - Matthew 21:5
  - Jas. 5:9; Rev. 6:10, 19:11
- Heb. 10:30 - Israel, Israel's enemies, and bless
- 2 Tim. 4:8 - the righteous judge
