### ① The First Section (loins, Breastplate, Feet)

- a) "having your loins girt about with truth"

• "loins" - Acts 2:30; HEB. 7:5

• not physical loins, but spiritual (the spiritual organ to bear fruit)

• reproductive organs girdled (belt)

• "loins of your mind" - 1 Pet. 1:13 (Job 38:3, 40:7)

• Romans 8:5 ① things of the Spirit (Jn. 15:26) ② mind

• Rom. 12:3

- We are to have our minds occupied with truth

• WIE - occupy your mind with darkness & error

① Numerous errors (Col. 2)

② Mediums to propagate errors

• Isa. 26:3

• Ps. 42:5, 11

• Ps. 50:23

• Eph. 4:17-18 - vanity of the world

① without truth you are unable to detect error

• be not ignorant (Rom. 1)

↳ ignorant statements

↳ seed of God's, but not according to knowledge (Rom. 10)
