Sermon:

"Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?"

- "Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers:"
 - **"be ye not"** command of negation, negative imperative
 - "unequally" disproportioned; ill matched; not uniform
 - **"yoked together"** confined in a yoke; joined, couple
 - a chain, a link; a bond of connection; a couple; a pair; to bring into bondage
 - a wooden beam normally used between a pair of oxen or other animals to enable them to pull together on a load when working in pairs

 - □ death to sin by the blood
 - □ then could relate with God
