    - Authority & men

- Men and women
- Bishops, deacons and the church
- Elder and younger
- Widows indeed and younger widows
- Masters and servants
- Rich and poor
- 1. "that they be not highminded"
- 2. "nor trust in uncertain riches"
- 3. "do good"
  - i. Rich in good works
  - ii. Ready to distribute
  - iii. Willing to communicate
  - iv. Laying up in store
  - v. Lay hold

#### • "rich in this world"

- There estate is that in which they have much in this world material things
  - Matt. 19:16-25

#### • "that they be not highminded"

- In a position on this earth in a higher position or having more materially in this world
- God's kingdom is not of this world
  - It isn't in the riches of this world
- Shouldn't be focused on the riches of this world, but the high calling of God in Christ Jesus

#### • "nor trust in uncertain riches"

- Test of trusting riches or things
  - Discontent, tiredness, disappointment,
  - Other effects lack of hope, not satisfaction in God, not rich toward God
- o Matt. 6:19-26
  - Luke 12:16-21
- o "uncertain" doubtful; not sure, no confidence, no hope

#### "but in the living God"

- Contrast to uncertain
- o "uncertain riches" fleshly/fashion of this world
- o Trust in God in this life
- "who giveth us richly all things to enjoy"

- Using them for God's purpose is life and joy
- o Get these reversed and its' idolatry
  - Idolatry to Enjoyment
  - Priority

# 1Ti 6:18 That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;

#### "That they do good"

Clear command "do good"

#### • "that they be rich in good works"

- Men authority today isn't the issue, but godliness today authority in the future
- Women outward appearance today isn't the issue, but godliness today glory in the future
- Rich riches today isn't the issue, but rich in good works glorious investment in the future

#### • "ready to distribute"

- o Rom. 12 "distribute to the necessity of saints"
- Distribution of wealth shouldn't want the government to distribute your wealth by way of tax we should do so freely readily
- o "ready" willing, instant, have it don't hold it
  - Don't lay hold on this life, but eternal life by distributing
- o "to distribute" to divide among two or more

# • "willing to communicate" - liberal

- o 2 Corinthians 8:1-2
- o 2 Corinthians 9:6-15

# 1Ti 6:19 Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

### • "Laying up in store"

- Building a supply, storing riches
  - Luke 12:18

# • "for themselves a good foundation against the time to come"

- "for themselves a good foundation"
  - A foundation that will last and persevere through the test of it
  - Matthew 7:26-27

### "against the time to come"

1 Cor. 3 - the judgment seat of Christ

- ☐ The time in which we give an account
- 2 Tim. 4:6-8
- "that they may lay hold on eternal life"
  - o "lay hold on" took, take hold, caught
    - To seize, catch

1Ti 6:20 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:
1Ti 6:21 Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with thee.
Amen

- "keep that which is committed to thy trust"
  - o 1 Timothy 4:12-16
- "avoiding profane and vain babblings"
  - o 1 Timothy 1:6, 4:1, 6:3-5
- "and oppositions of science falsely so called:"
  - o Knowledge that opposes the faith
  - o Knowledge that is false, but taken for truth
  - o Erred to miss the mark, deviate from truth
    - 1 Tim. 1:6 "swerved"
    - 2 Tim. 2:18 "erred" resurrection
