

L14 | Prophecy 103 | The Davidic Covenant | Heb. 10:1-14

I. Intro/Review:

- Review of "The Failure of the Kings"
 - 1st CoP to the end
 - Saul, David, Solomon
 - 2nd-5th CoP
 - The king "did evil in the sight of the LORD"
- Lessons
 1. Main's failure in authority - "and made Israel to sin"
 2. Point to a King - make Israel righteous

II. Preview:

- Abraham to David = 14 generations (Matt. 1:17, Acts 7:45, Heb. 4:7)
 - Abraham to David
 - Joshua to David
- Review
 - 1st CoP - end they want a king
 - Deut. 17:14-20
 - 1 Sam. 8:1ff
 - Under 1st CoP they get Saul
- David & Solomon
 - Golden Age of Israel - Acts 1:6 - "Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?"
 - Daniel
 - Foretaste of Glory
- Davidic Covenant

III. Sermon:

- Davidic Covenant
 - We follow the seed of Adam, Abraham, to David - Gen. 3:15
 - We remember the 5 major lessons Israel was to learn regarding what they need from God
 - Redemption
 - Deliverance
 - Avengement
 - King
 - Blessing

- Historical Context
 - 1 Samuel 12:17-18 - asking for the king was deserving of 2nd CoP
 - Instead of 2nd CoP - with a man after God's own heart by His mercy and compassion (Ex. 33:19)
 - Provides - Deliverance, Avengement, King, and Blessing
 - Redemption - not spiritual, David is compromised with sin
- 2 Samuel 7; the Psalms; Isa. 9
- 2 Samuel 7:10-17
 - (:10-11) - 1st CoP
 - (:11) - "LORD telleth thee that he will make thee an house."
 - (:13) - "He shall build an house for my name"
 - "I will make thee an house."
 - The mystery of godliness - 1 Tim. 3:16
 - Rom. 1, 2 Tim. 2
 - David's son and David's Lord (Ps. 110) would take on flesh
 - Isa. 9
 - Isa. 7:14
 - Mic. 5:2
 - Ps. 132:11 - "The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; He will not turn from it; of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne."
 - Matt. 22:41-46
 - Rev. 22:16 - "the root and offspring of David"
 - Body
 - Heb. 10:5
 - Rom. 7, 9, 2 Cor. 5, Heb. 2
 - Kingdom, Throne, Family

IV. Conclusion:

- The Son of God will come and take up a body through David's seed line
- The Christ will fulfill being the redeemer, deliverer, avenger, king, and blesser
 - Redeemer in first coming (gives Him all power)
 - Spiritual things - mystery of Christ to clean house even in the heavenly places
 - Deliverer, Avenger, King, and Blesser in second coming (execution of all power)
