L1 | "This World and The World to Come" | Ephesians 1:15-2:3

I. Intro/Review:

- We live in "this world" however it may be that we don't know much about it. Our understanding of "this world" is hindered by the truth that we live within it, we dwell on the earth.
- The verbiage of our understanding is dictated by those who have gone before us and what was passed to them; however they too were and are limited by theirs and others carnal perspective.
- Yet, at the same time, although we get understanding from the limited perspective of ourselves and others, it is important to know the "things of this world" for we live therein.
- "This world" and all those therein "look at the things which are seen for the things which are seen are temporal;"
- For those "in Christ" we have received so much more than just what "eye can see" and "hear can hear" or that which the "heart" can conjure up in its imaginations and fancies. Those in Christ gain two more fundamental things for consideration -
 - 1. The knowledge and understanding of another world, not this world a world greater than this one, a world that is and is to come, and

- Period of time, age, course, "beginning of the, while the", without end
- The worlds, universe
- Forever, an unbroken age, perpetuity of time, eternity

 - New Testament 38 exact matches of the phrase
 - From Matt. 12:32 to Rev. 11:15
 - Inexact matches but close
 - Gal. 1:4 "this present evil world"
 - 2 Tim. 4:10 "having love this present world,"
 - Tit. 2:12 "this present world"

2. Contrasts

 - Matt. 12:32 "neither in this world, neither in the world to come"
 - Mar. 10:30 "But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life."
 - Luke 18:30 "Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting."
