III. Sermon:

Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; {Eph. 2:15}

- "for"
 - The explanation of "why" He abolished in His flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances.
 - 1. To break down the middle wall of partition
 - 2. Made both one our peace
 - Enmity between God and man and enmity between Jew and Gentile.

• To Make

- "to make in Himself of twain"
 - "to make" back to creation/Eph. 2:10, 4:23-24
 - "in Himself" in Christ
 - "of Him, through Him, to Him"
 - Those not "in Him" are not a "new man" and Jews and Gentiles the twain therefore not "one new man".

• Of Twain One New Man

- "of twain"
 - Two Israelites and Gentiles made in Christ one new man
 - Not identified on the basis of their flesh
- "one new man"
 - Not two new mans not a new man for the Israelites and a new man for the Gentiles
 - Rather, the new man in which the twain are made one in
 - References: Eph. 2:15, 4:24, Col. 3:10
 - New creature references: 2 Cor. 5:17, Gal. 6:15
 - One a joining instead of twain
 - Eph. 1:10 heaven and earth
 - Eph. 2:15 one new man
 - Eph. 2:16 one body
 - Eph. 5:31 one flesh
 - New Man
 - Gentiles given up (sinners) Rom. 2:12-16
 - Israelites God nigh them (sinners) Rom. 2:17-29
 - Equals Rom. 3:9-20
 - One Man Rom. 5:11-21
 - 1 Cor. 15:21-22 death and resurrection
 - 1 Cor. 15:45, 47 first to second and last
- "so making peace;"
 - "in His flesh" Abolished in His flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances
 - Done, but not recognized 2 Cor. 3:14-16
 - "He is our peace" once Israelites and once Gentiles now in Christ is the peace between us
 - Gal. 3:26-29
 - Col. 3:10-11
 - Our peace with God through Jesus Christ becomes our peace
 - All sinners, under sin, guilty before God
 - In Christ forgiveness, and righteousness, and the promise of eternal life
