### III. Sermon:

- The Role of Government
  - Gen. 6:11, 13 violence
  - Gen. 9:5-6 at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man; shedding of blood
  - Gen. 11:9 scatter nations upon the face of the earth
    - Nations = families, borders, tongues
  - Ex. 20:13 "thou shalt not kill"
  - Num. 35:19 the revenger of blood
  - Historically you have two things
    - Sin, corruption, murder (Rom. 1:29ff)
    - Government to be a terror to it (Rom. 2:14-15)
    - Yet, it can be corrupted or its sword can be abused
- Terror & Praise
  - Rom. 13:3 not a terror to good works (non-violence), but to the evil (violence)
  - Rom. 13:3 do that which is good praise of the same (not praise for everything)
  - Rom. 13:4 if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil
  - Mar. 15:7 Barabbas...made insurrection...who had committed murder in the insurrection
    - Insurrection
    - Rioting
    - Rom. 13:13 rioting and drunkenness
    - 1 Pet. 4:1-9

- Corruption of Power
  - Lev. 26:19 break the pride of your power
  - Isa. 5:20-23
  - Php. 2:15

- 1. Prayer 1 Tim. 2:1
- 2. Lead Quiet and Peaceable Life 1 Tim. 2:2
- 3. Share Gospel 1 Tim. 2:4-5
- 4. Rich in good works 1 Tim. 2:8; Tit. 3:1-7
- 5. Subject Rom. 13:5; 1 Pet. 2:13-17
  - 1. For wrath terror of sword
  - 2. For conscience minister of God
- Example 1 Sam. 24:22
  - David knew he was being pursued unjustly, but did not sin in killing Saul.
- 6. Taxes Matt. 22:17ff
  - Not because of their corruption they will be responsible for what they do
  - You will be responsible for rendering or not for conscience sake
- Focus is righteousness, even in the midst of unrighteousness
  - 1. Know these things
  - 2. You are free to use that which is legally available to you as long as it is line with God's Word
    - Acts 25:11
  - 3. When tempted to do unrighteousness to extend justice for yourself
    - 1. 1 Pet. 2:21-24 commit yourself to Him that judgeth righteously
      Vengeance is His (Rom. 13)
    - 2. 1 Pet. 3:14-16 suffer for righteousness' sake
  - 4. When the government asks you to do that which Christ hasn't commanded
    - Christ is our Lord Acts 5:29 "obey God rather than men."
- Part and parcel of suffering for Christ's sake
  - Php. 3:1ff
  - We are to be more concerned about righteousness then flesh
    - 1 Pet. 4:1ff
    - Rom. 13:8-14
