Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye.
{1 Corinthians 16:1}

- 1. Collection for the saints
  - "Now concerning the collection for the saints"
    - 1. "collection" money gathered for the relief of the poor
      - 1 Cor. 16:2 "gatherings"
    - 2. "for the saints"
      - Acts 2:44-45 "sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men,

as every man had need."

- "give to the poor" Matt. 19:21, Luke 12:33
- Acts 4:32, 34-35 "And laid them down at the apostle' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need."
- Acts 5:1ff "sold a possession"
  - Lifestyle reflective of the kingdom of heaven where there treasure is in heaven, sacrifice their goods for the profit of others
  - James 2:1-6
- Rom. 15:25-26 "poor saints at Jerusalem"
- Gal. 2:10 "Only they would that we should remember the poor; the same which I also was **forward** to do."
  - Rom. 12:13 "distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality"
    - In view of "hope"
  - Balance of giving to the poor and what Paul says elsewhere
    - 2 The. 3:8-12
    - Eph. 4:28

Upon the first [day] of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as [God] hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

{1 Corinthians 16:2}

### 2. Lay by Him in Store

#### 1. When?

- "upon the first day of the week" in view of the week's labor and wages they would then lay by him in store
- "lay by him in store" isn't the issue of putting in his own pocket, but the act of communicating to the poor
  - An understanding that the distribution of worldly goods should translate in the mind of the believer of laying up in store in heaven ACTS 20:35,

"I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the wors of the Lord Jesus, how

# He said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive.""

- Luke 12:16-21, 33-34
- Luke 18:22
- Col. 3:1-4 set affection on things above
- 1 Tim. 6:17-19
- We ought to labor to be wise in giving, simple in giving, and liberal in giving.

#### 2. How much?

- "as God hath prospered him"
  - Paul had a view of men laboring under the sun thus ultimately it was God prospering them, they were working with their hands in God's creation
  - "prospered" succeed in business affairs
    - Creation
    - A Job
    - Instruction of Diligence
    - Eph. 6:5-8
  - The amount of that which the man prospered isn't determined by God here, therefore
    - 1. It was up to the judgment of the one prospered by God, and
      - 2 Cor. 9:6
      - Purposeth in his heart
    - 2. The amount may vary
      - Sparingly or bountifully

## 3. Why?

- "that there be no gathering when I come"
  - 2 Cor. 9:7 "...not grudgingly, or of necessity

And when I come, whomsoever ye shall approve by [your] letters, them will I send to bring your liberality unto Jerusalem. And if it be meet that I go also, they shall go with me. {1 Corinthians 16:3}

#### 3. Liberality unto Jerusalem

- 1. Approve by letters
  - "And when I come"
  - "whomsoever ye shall approve by your letters, them will I send"
    - 2 Cor. 8:18-24
- 2. Sent to bring to Jerusalem

- "them will I send to bring your liberality unto Jerusalem."
  - Gentiles giving to Jews because of Chist
  - Gentiles who, take thought of what they eat, drink, and clothing (Matt. 6:31-32) giving of their treasures, prosperity, and even necessities
  - **Liberality** not bound by the things of the earth, because they are free in Christ, liberated by His resurrection unto the heavenly places the better world to come.
