 - Ⓐ End of the world (MATT. 24:3, 6, 13 (:29)
 - Ⓑ End of death (1 COR. 15:22-28; REV. 1:18, 20:13-14 (:2-7)

• The end of prophecy is God's kingdom through His Son established on earth with all things restituted & reconciled for His glory.

• Rev. 11:15 (Dan. 2:44) (expected end - Jer. 29:11, 31:17)

• "the kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of His Christ."

- All power (post resurrection - Matt. 28:18)
- Kingdoms given (Ps. 2:1-8 (:92))
- Kingdoms destroyed (Dan. 2:44)
- Kingdoms preserved (Matt. 25:31A)
