**Prioritize prayer.**

**Psalm 5:3 (NIV)**

**Have a place of prayer.**

**Mark 1:35 (NIV)**

Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.

**Have a plan for prayer.**

**Luke 11:1 (NLT)**

Once Jesus was in a certain place praying. As he finished, one of his disciples came to him and said, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples."

**Luke 11:2 (NLT)**

Jesus said, "This is how you should pray"

**Matthew 17:20 (NKJV)**

So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.
