DISCUSSION Read Ecclesiastes 5:10, 13-17

Read Proverbs 30:8-9

How do you balance this prayer request of not having too much but also not struggling to provide for your family?

What is "enough?" When do we know that we are being consumed with greed instead of living full of generosity?

How has "living as a family" helped you break the vice of greed and embrace the virtue of generosity?

Who is someone who has modeled Christ like generosity for you?

Why do you think we as human beings are consumed with wanting more? What advice does Jesus give about where to invest our time, money and resources?

How would you say you are storing up treasures in heaven through generosity?

Why does living a life of generosity stand out in today's world and makes other ask why are we so generous?



How would replacing Greed with Generosity in our lives draw others who are far from God closer to a relationship with him?
