What do you think the woman who was caught in adultery, thought after Jesus told her to go and sin no more?

Read John 8:31-36

How does our society and culture define truth? How is that different than what Jesus says truth is?

Read Romans 6:22

How does Jesus set us free from our sins? What does it mean to be a slave of righteousness?

As you read the story of the woman caught in adultery, what does this reveal to you about the character of Jesus?

What does it mean to have Freedom in Christ to you? What does a Slave of righteousness look like?

How does the local church reflect the crowd with the stones in their hands? How does the local church reflect Jesus in showing grace to the woman caught in sin?

Can you think of time where a situation looked black and white, but the church chose the messy middle of grace and truth?

Would those who are far from be surprised by Jesus' response to the woman caught in adultery? Why or why not?
