Big Idea: Will we listen to our heavenly Father who lovingly leads us and guides us, or will we

harden our hearts like Israel and chose our own path?

Bible Discussion

Read **Hebrews 3:1-6**

Moses is called the servant of the house and Jesus the son of God's house. What is the difference in these two roles?

How did Moses' role of a servant, support Jesus' role as a son? Who would have the greater authority in the household of God?

Read **Hebrews 3:7-11**

Who does verse 7 says – gave the words for Psalm 95? How does that support the idea that Bible wasn't written by men?

What led to the rebellion of Israel? In what ways did God reveal himself to Israel to show his faithfulness and love?

What is the rest that is mentioned in verse 11? What does it mean "not enter my rest?"

Read Hebrews 3:12-14

What kind of heart does a rebellion against God lead to?

What is the remedy of an unbelieving heart and to ensure our hearts are not harden to the voice of the Lord?

What is something that has helped you Endure as walk with Christ? What is something that you would like to add to your life to ensure that you are able to endure?

Growing in Christ

What is Jesus revealing about himself to you in Hebrews 3?

Which heart describes your current heart condition – rebellious (hard) or obedient (soft)? Why?

Is there an area of your life that could be seen a hypocritical because of a hard heart?

Living as a Family

When you hear that we are part of the family of God- the household of God, how does that make you feel?

Who has "exhorted" or encouraged you to ensure that you endure in your relationship with Christ? Who do you need to exhort through a kind word this week?

Sharing the Gospel

How can we make sure that we aren't living a life of hypocrisy for those outside the church?

What happens to our witness when we have a rebellion of the heart and don't obey the voice of God?
