At the end of Proverbs 2, we see a path of wisdom described. What is on that path and what do those who fail to stay on the path receive?

How did Jesus model wisdom and the power of discernment? What can you learn in the example of Jesus in the wisdom he modeled?

How do you see the connection to King Solomon writing to his son, and the connection of God the Father bestowing wisdom on God the Son?

How has living as a family helped you is gaining wisdom and applying wisdom?
