Wrong Definitions of Evangelism

- Doing things that might draw people close to the point of conversion but not speaking the gospel is not evangelism
 - You'll have everyone doing the activities, but the gospel will never be preached
 - Everyone will think that they are doing evangelism resulting in gospelless ministry
 - Its very easy to believe that



Wrong Definitions of Evangelism

- Winning souls is not evangelism - its just one of the fruits
 - Five results that happen from this definition
 - We will think when people don't come to God then we failed
 - We will sometimes become a salesman of the gospel for the results that we want
 - Watering down the gospel to get results
 - Discouragement from not seeing results
 - People will rule out strategies of Evangelism (tracks, altercalls)

The Gospel

- The fall of man lead to the curse of sin and death
 - Gen 3:11-12,19
 - "Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?" Then the man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate."
 - "In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread till you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; For dust you are, And to dust you shall return."
- Because all have sinned, the consequence is death and hell
 - Rom 3:23, 6:23
 - "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."
 - "For the wages of sin is death"





The Gospel

- Jesus is fully man, fully God, without sin, took our sin and our punishment upon Himself
- Jesus died a criminals' death on the cross, that we deserved
- Jesus was buried for 3 days
- Jesus rose on the 3rd day and is alive today!
- Jesus is waiting for you to accept Him

Why Did Jesus Come?

- Jesus came to seek and save those that are lost
 - Luke 19:10
 - "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was Lost."
- Paul says about Jesus
 - 1st Tim 1:15
 - "This is the faithful saying, worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into this world to save sinners, of whom I am Chief"

What is His desire for us

John 17:18

- As You have sent Me into the World, I also have sent them into the world.

What is our Purpose on Earth

- Ministers of Reconciliation

- 2nd Cor. 5:17-20

- Therefore, if anyone is in Christ , he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold all things are made new. Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, that God was in Christ Reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us

What Does Jesus Mean?

- Luke 10:4,8-10
 - Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road.
 - Jesus here literally states not to rely on your own self to be perfect but to rely on Him
 - Money bag
 - Your own finances to get you to have results
 - Knapsack
 - Your past experience and wisdoms
 - Sandals
 - Your own way that you choose
 - God is asking for you to become reliant on His Holy Spirit when you go out, because it isn't all about you, it is about Revealing Him!
 - Go where God has called you, heal the sick, preach the Gospel by the leading of the Holy Spirit, This is true evangelism. Do not rely on yourself, its all about Him!

What Does Jesus Mean?

- Matt 16:18
 - I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.
 - Jesus didn't build the church to be a building for people to gather and shelter away from the world. Jesus built the church as a people who can run into the enemy's territory and destroy the gates of Hell
 - Our job is to destroy hell for a living!

5 Key Tips to Share Your Faith



1. Be Aware of Those Around You





2. Be Willing to Initiate



3. Use Your Testimony

5. Ask The Question

Jesus at the door, please download the app on your phone



? Have you seen this picture before? Do you pray?



This is Jesus knocking on the door of your heart. The handle's on the inside, only you can let Him in.



Lots of people pray, but praying can be like talking through the door. You know He's there somewhere, but you don't know Him personally.



Visualize wearing a backpack. If we filled it with all your sin, would it be heavy? That represents your debt with God. It stops you from having a relationship with Him.



If you owed the bank a million dollars and I gave you a check for that amount, and you gave it to the bank, what would happen to your debt?



That's what Jesus did when He died on the cross. He wrote you a check signed in His blood - with your name on it. He rose again, and today, He's standing at the door of your heart, wanting you to cash it.



If Jesus were here right now, would you let Him in?



Can you see the wind? No, but you can feel it, right? Like the wind, Jesus is here right now. Can I pray for you to feel His Presence? *(After prayer)* What did you feel?



Right now, you're on a road of life without Jesus. You need to turn from your sin, change direction and follow Him. Do you want to follow Him?



Jesus, forgive me for my sins. I open the door of my heart. I make you Lord of my life. Fill me with your Spirit. Amen.

What is JAD?

JAD is "evangelism made easy". It's the gospel simplified, made for 1:1 evangelism in the modern world.

The tool also allows you trust the Holy Spirit in the process so that you and I would be co-missioned with the Spirit during evangelism and allow Him to do His part.

Does it work?

Ministries like CFAN have seen millions of souls saved through the use of this tool and we see plenty of others around the world start using it.

Mindset

- Your mindset coming into this should be how can I retain this person's attention for the next 5 minutes to snatch them from the gates of hell.
- Which means you need to be engaging when presenting the gospel
- Look them in the eyes
- Be confident and extroverted, and if you're not naturally extroverted, you're going to have to simply not be yourself for the next 5 minutes.
- People are attracted to confidence and boldness
- Remember, you're a representative of Jesus. Take on the personality of Jesus and shine the love of Christ and do it with faith.

First Step

Ask for their attention.

Since usually you're going to be outdoors than indoors, you have to be loud and clear that you want their attention.

Simply say "Hey, can I ask you a question?".

You may be comfortable skipping this and going straight into JAD, but depending on the situation you can decide to ask the question or not.



This is the picture that inspired JAD. Scott had a vision of Jesus knocking on the door of a heart when he asked God to show him a better way to evangelize.

People don't need a supernatural encounter of Jesus like Paul did walking to Damascus if you show them a picture of an actual vision.

Same thing with feeling the love of God. They don't need to have a supernatural encounter to feel the love of Jesus when you're there representing Jesus and can give them a hug.

They can feel Jesus through you.

1. The Picture

2. Explanation
