I am moving forward daily with all the renovations and updates in the youth center. With these updates, there are items on my shopping list for each area. We would like to have 4 cubby storage units, 1 for the nursery, 1 for preschool, and 2 for the k-6 classroom. I'll be including the price for 2 dozen bins to fill the cubby slots, in the total goal amount. We're also looking to mount tvs in both the nursery and preschool room rather than having carts that are potential trip hazards. I have 4 items that will come from IKEA and the rest are in my church shopping cart on Amazon. This includes 6 new shelves for the resource room too. Anything above and beyond our goal will be used towards paint, sofa and chair covers, and any resources we are running low on in the resource room.

Your support so far has been humbling and completely awesome. As you continue to support the youth, our hope and prayer is that we will continue to grow and expand and be able to take on more students.

As of now, the total needed, minus the paint, totals \$1100.
