Sermon Title: "UNMASKED: STOP PERFORMING AND START LIVING."

Call To Worship

Leader: While physical masks are designed to protect us from what's around us, spiritual masks often conceal the true condition of our hearts. And when acceptance becomes more important than authenticity, we can hinder the deliverance God desires for us through healing, conviction, repentance, and His grace.

Ps 139:23-24; 1 Sam 16:7; Gal 1:10; Matt 23:27-28

Congregation: God loves us too much to let us live behind something He never designed, (spiritual masks). His truth exposes and frees us from the identity theft the enemy tries to perpetuate in our lives. "For there is nothing hidden that will not be disclosed, and nothing concealed that will not be known or brought out into the open." *Ps 51:6; Luke 8:17*

ALL: Renewing our minds with God's truth is our pathway toward spiritual unmasking and lasting freedom. As we replace lies with truth, we step fully into the identity God originally designed for us. Scripture Reading/Lesson: Psalm 25:1-5 (NIV)

Leader: 1 In you, Lord my God, I put my trust. **2** I trust in you; do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.

Congregation: 3 No one who hopes in you will ever be put to shame, but shame will come on those who are treacherous without cause.
