Sermon Title: "THIS IS HOW HE DOES IT."

Call To Worship

Leader: While God is all-knowing, He invites us into an active relationship through intentional prayer. He is our benefactor, our shield; the source of "every good and perfect gift." When we call on Him, He surrounds us with protection "on every side." *Matt* 7:7–8; *James* 5:16; 1 John 5:14; Job 1:10

Congregation: When we gather in faith to pray collectively with purpose and expectation, the Lord is "in the midst" and heaven responds with exponential power. God multiplies the impact of united obedience and prayer.

Matt 18:19-20; Acts 4:31; Lev 26:8

ALL: God opposes pride and rebellion. He actively lifts those who walk in faith. His justice humbles rebellion, but His mercy crowns belief with blessings (hearing prayers, granting mercy, grace and healing). AMEN.

2 Chron 7:14; James 4:6; Ps 138:6; 84:11



Scripture Lesson: 2 Chron 32:9-10; 16-22 (NIV)

Leader: 9 Later, when Sennacherib king of Assyria and all his forces were laying siege to Lachish, he sent his officers to Jerusalem with this message for Hezekiah king of Judah and for all the people of Judah who were there: 10 "This is what Sennacherib king of Assyria says: On what are you basing your confidence, that you remain in Jerusalem under siege?

Congregation: 16 Sennacherib's officers spoke further against the Lord God and against his servant Hezekiah. 17 The king also wrote letters ridiculing the Lord, the God of Israel, and saying this against him: "Just as the gods of the peoples of the other lands did not rescue their people from my hand, so the god of Hezekiah will not rescue his people from my hand."

Leader: 18 Then they called out in Hebrew to the people of Jerusalem who were on the wall, to terrify them and make them afraid in order to capture the city. **19** They spoke about the God of Jerusalem as they did about the gods of the other peoples of the world—the work of human hands.

Congregation: 20 King Hezekiah and the prophet Isaiah son of Amoz cried out in prayer to heaven about this. 21 And the Lord sent an angel, who annihilated all the fighting men and the commanders and officers in the camp of the Assyrian king. So he withdrew to his own land in disgrace. And when he went into the temple of his god, some of his sons, his own flesh and blood, cut him down with the sword.

ALL: 22 So the Lord saved Hezekiah and the people of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib king of Assyria and from the hand of all others. He took care of them on every side. AMEN.
