Call To Worship

Leader: If we stay within the lines that God has marked, we will find ourselves on the straight and narrow path of righteousness. "Keep straight the path of your feet, and all your ways will be sure. ... turn your foot away from evil." *Prov 4:25-27; Psalm 119:33*

Congregation: Scripture challenges us to examine ourselves. Does our life give identity to integrity or a religious performance? "Do we walk the walk of integrity?" By God's grace, we can live with integrity and be truth-tellers. *2 Cor 13:5; Matt 23:27-28; Prov 20:7*

ALL: If we desire Christ to be illuminated in our lives, we must submit to His lordship. "Trust in the Lord ... lean not on [our] own understanding; ... and he will make [our] paths straight. *Prov 3:5-6*

Scripture Lesson: 1 Chronicles 29:11-17 (NIV)

Leader: 11 Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is yours. Yours, Lord, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all. **12** Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all.

Congregation: 13 Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name. **14** "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.

Leader: 15 We are foreigners and strangers in your sight, as were all our ancestors. Our days on earth are like a shadow, without hope.

16 Lord our God, all this abundance that we have provided for building you a temple for your Holy Name comes from your hand, and all of it belongs to you.

ALL: 17 I know, my God, that you test the heart and are pleased with integrity. All these things I have given willingly and with honest intent. And now I have seen with joy how willingly your people who are here have given to you. AMEN.

Pastor: 1 Cor. 11:23 (KJV)

For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

1 Cor 11:24 (NLT) 24 and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Congregation: John 6:35 (KJV)

And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

Pastor: 1 Cor. 11:25 (KJV)

After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

Congregation: Hebrews 9:22 (KJV)
