Sermon Title: “TRUST, AND DO NOT DOUBT.”

Call To Worship

Leader: Faith is our foundation, but trust is how we live it out. When we surrender self-reliance, God guides our path. Even a mustard seed of faith, placed in His absolute sovereignty, changes everything—leaving no shadow of doubt that He is God Almighty. Let us worship the One who is completely worthy of our trust today.

ALL: May our trust be far more than a static word; let it be an active step of daily obedience. Let us move forward in faith declaring beyond a shadow of doubt that Jesus is our living Savior “... hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.” AMEN.

Scripture Reading: Ezra 8:21-25 (NIV)

Leader: 21 There, by the Ahava Canal, I proclaimed a fast, so that we might humble ourselves before our God and ask him for a safe journey for us and our children, with all our possessions.

Congregation: 22 I was ashamed to ask the king for soldiers and horsemen to protect us from enemies on the road, because we had told the king, “The gracious hand of our God is on everyone who looks to him, but his great anger is against all who forsake him.”

23 So we fasted and petitioned our God about this, and he answered our prayer.

ALL: 24 Then I set apart twelve of the leading priests, namely, Sherebiah, Hashabiah and ten of their brothers, **25** and I weighed out to them the offering of silver and gold and the articles that the king, his advisers, his officials and all Israel present there had donated for the house of our God. AMEN.

PASTOR: 1 Cor. 11:23 (KJV)

For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

1 Cor 11:24 (NLT) 24 and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”
