Call To Worship

Leader: Welcome to the house of the LORD! Sopranos, altos, tenors, and basses each bring unique voices, yet they form one unified sound. In the same way, God calls us to live in true spiritual oneness—vital for the health and mission of the church. *1 Cor 12:4-7; 12:12*

Congregation: The choir stand reminds us that we are not here to compete, but to complete one another. In God's kingdom, there are no solo acts—only a collective harmony designed to elevate His praise, not our own glory.

Phil 2:3; 1 Cor 12:21-26

ALL: Though the enemy brings discord, God gives victory when we stand in one accord! As we silence division and lift one voice, our oneness opens the door to everything God has in store for us—a sound hell fears and God favors. Let us praise Him in true harmony today! AMEN.

Psalms 133:1-3; Ephesians 4:3-6



Scripture Reading: 2 Chronicles 5:1,2,5, 11-14 (NKJV)

Leader 5:1 So all the work that Solomon had done for the house of the LORD was finished; and Solomon brought in the things which his father David had dedicated: the silver and the gold and all the furnishings. And he put them in the treasuries of the house of God.

Congregation 5:2 Now Solomon assembled the elders of Israel and all the heads of the tribes, the chief fathers of the children of Israel, in Jerusalem, that they might bring the ark of the covenant of the Lord up from the City of David, which is Zion. **5** Then they brought up the ark, the tabernacle of meeting, and all the holy furnishings that were in the tabernacle. The priests and the Levites brought them up.

Leader: 5:11 And it came to pass when the priests came out of the Most Holy Place (for all the priests who were present had sanctified themselves, without keeping to their divisions), **12** and the Levites who were the singers, all those of Asaph and Heman and Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, stood at the east end of the altar, clothed in white linen, having cymbals, stringed instruments and harps, and with them one hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets—

ALL 5:13 indeed it came to pass, when the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the Lord, and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the Lord, saying: "For He is good, For His mercy endures forever," that the house, the house of the Lord, was filled with a cloud, **14** so that the priests could not [e]continue ministering because of the cloud; for the glory of the Lord filled the house of God. AMEN.
