Call To Worship

Leader: It's truly a 'love-thing' the "... great love the Father has lavished on us." He provides comfort in sorrow, joy that rises from within and power to withstand life challenges. "The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God."

Congregation: A personal encounter with God is transforming and sets us on a spiritual trajectory of repentance, forgiveness and redemption. Thus says the Lord, "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you... I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes." *Ezekiel* 36:26–27; *Titus* 3:5

ALL: When feelings fade, we can activate our power through the Holy Spirit to anchor us; it is our compass, not our mood. It is the spirit-filled strength that heals, restores, empowers our witness and anchors our identity in Christ. This power is active, present, and ours. AMEN. *Acts* 1:8; Luke 4:14; 1 Cor 2:4; 2 Tim 1:7



Scripture Lesson: Romans 5: 1-5 (NIV)

Leader: 1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God.

Congregation: 3 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; 4 perseverance, character; and character, hope.

ALL: 5 And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. AMEN
