Sermon Title: "GO TELL SOMEBODY."

Call To Worship

Leader: On this glorious Resurrection Sunday, we come ready to remember, to rejoice and to testify. God specializes in opening doors we didn't even know existed. When God grants access, creates opportunity, or shifts circumstances, it becomes a testimony worth sharing. Go tell somebody. *Rev 3:8; Acts 14:27*

Congregation: Because Jesus lives and reigns, the story doesn't end at the cross or the tomb. We don't testify to a memory — we testify about a living Savior who is active, present, and ruling. He lives! Go tell somebody. *Rev 1:18; Rom 8:34; Acts 2:32-33*

ALL: Faith positions us to witness God's divine power. "Did I not tell you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?" Once we experience His glory, we are not just inspired, we are compelled and obligated to go tell somebody. AMEN. *Heb 11:6; John 11:40*

Scripture Lesson: Mark 16: 1-7 (NIV)

Leader: 1 When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. **2** Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb

Congregation: 3 and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?" **4** But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away.

Leader: 5 As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed.

Congregation: 6 "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him.

ALL: 7 But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'" AMEN.
