Sermon Title: "SCRAPING BEATS DRAPING."

Call To Worship

Leader: Hope is the alarm clock of the soul; it awakens our hearts and lifts our spirits. It stirs us to rise from spiritual heaviness to urgency, effort, and intentional action—so we can do the work God has placed in our hands.

Rom 15:13; Isa 40:31; Rom 13:11

Congregation: A growing hope shapes better choices, behaviors, and a more spiritually enriched way of living. Our hope in the Lord is "... as an anchor for [our] soul, firm and secure" — it is transformative.

Psalms 27:13; Col 3:23; Pro 23:18; Heb 6:19

ALL: Scripture reminds us that our struggles are not random — "because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope." And so we press on, trusting that God is working in us and through us. *Romans 5:3-4; James 1:2-4* AMEN.



Scripture Reading: Ecclesiastes 9:3-10 (NIV)

Leader: 3 This is the evil in everything that happens under the sun: The same destiny overtakes all. The hearts of people, moreover, are full of evil and there is madness in their hearts while they live, and afterward they join the dead.

Congregation; 4 Anyone who is among the living has hope—even a live dog is better off than a dead lion! **5** For the living know that they will die, but the dead know nothing; they have no further reward, and even their name is forgotten.

Leader: 6 Their love, their hate and their jealousy have long since vanished; never again will they have a part in anything that happens under the sun.

7 Go, eat your food with gladness, and drink your wine with a joyful heart, for God has already approved what you do.

Congregation: 8 Always be clothed in white and always anoint your head with oil. **9** Enjoy life with your wife, whom you love, all the days of this meaningless life that God has given you under the sun—all your meaningless days. For this is your lot in life and in your toilsome labor under the sun.

ALL: 10 Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might, for in the realm of the dead, where you are going, there is neither working nor planning nor knowledge nor wisdom. AMEN.
