Sermon Title:

"THE GREATEST LOVE."

Call To Worship

Leader: If we really want to know the source of true love, we must look to God Almighty. His divine sacrifice reveals the greatest love of all time: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son." *Rom 5:8; John 3:16*

Congregation: God's love transforms us, calls us to obedience, and inspires us to worship in spirit and truth. Subsequently, we are compelled to demonstrate our gratitude by aligning our will and our way to His Word. Considering God's mercy and love, we are urged to serve as a "living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is [our] reasonable service."

ALL: Though we can never repay the sacrifice Jesus made at the cross, we can reflect our gratitude by sharing His message of love with one another. We adopt God's biblical M.O. (modus operandi) for love when we sow seeds of love, grace, and kindness. AMEN.



Scripture Lesson: John 15:9-14 (NIV)

Leader: 9 "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love.

Congregation: 10 If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love.

Leader: 11 I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

Congregation: 12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

ALL: 14 You are my friends if you do what I command. AMEN
