Call To Worship

Leader: As people of God, we know "... that all things work together for good to them that ... are the called according to His purpose." We can trust the Lord is looking out for us and recognize "... it is He that provides the increase." *Rom 8:28; Psa 13:5-6; Jer 29:11*

Congregation: As we get closer to God, we gain the confidence to trust with all our heart, and resist putting any confidence in the flesh. *Prov 3:5-6; Psa 56:8; 135-6; 2 Cor 12:9*

ALL: When we are the facing "the fiery arrows aimed at [us] by Satan." Let us find the same courage to trust God as scripture tells of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego who were actually thrown in the into a physical fiery furnace. God delivered them and He is no respecter or persons, Let us trust that He will also deliver us! AMEN. *Eph 6:16-18; Dan 3:16-28; Rom 2:11-16*

Scripture Lesson: Daniel 6:1-10 (NIV)

Leader: 1 It pleased Darius to appoint 120 satraps to rule throughout the kingdom, **2** with three administrators over them, one of whom was Daniel. The satraps were made accountable to them so that the king might not suffer loss.

Congregation: 3 Now Daniel so distinguished himself among the administrators and the satraps by his exceptional qualities that the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom.

Leader: 4 At this, the administrators and the satraps tried to find grounds for charges against Daniel in his conduct of government affairs, but they were unable to do so. They could find no corruption in him, because he was trustworthy and neither corrupt nor negligent.

Congregation: 5 Finally these men said, "We will never find any basis for charges against this man Daniel unless it has something to do with the law of his God." **6** So these administrators and satraps went as a group to the king and said: "May King Darius live forever!

Leader: 7 The royal administrators, prefects, satraps, advisers and governors have all agreed that the king should issue an edict and enforce the decree that anyone who prays to any god or human being during the next thirty days, except to you, Your Majesty, shall be thrown into the lions' den.

Congregation: 8 Now, Your Majesty, issue the decree and put it in writing so that it cannot be altered—in accordance with the law of the Medes and Persians, which cannot be repealed." **9** So King Darius put the decree in writing.

ALL: 10 Now when Daniel learned that the decree had been published, he went home to his upstairs room where the windows opened toward Jerusalem. Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before. AMEN.

Pastor: 1 Cor. 11:23 (KJV)
