Sermon Title:

"EACH ONE TEACH ONE."

Call To Worship

Leader: People of God, as we kick off a month of celebrating Black History, let us remember that our life story matters—before God and before the generations who will follow. Let us hold fast to our identity, our testimony, and our God-given legacy. *Deut. 32:7*

Congregation: The history God has written in us is not meant to fade or be forgotten. What He has done deserves to remain clear to those around us and those who will follow. Each of us have a sacred role—to keep His works visible by living as a testimony of His faithfulness. *Psalm 145:4*

ALL: Our victories, struggles, and deliverance testimonies carry power. Someone's breakthrough is tied to our story. Let us pass it on—so others may rise, believe, and overcome by God's grace. "We overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony." AMEN. *2 Cor 1:3-4; Rev 12:11*



Scripture Lesson/Reading: Psalm 78: 1-8 (NIV)

Leader: 1 My people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth. 2 I will open my mouth with a parable; I will utter hidden things, things from of old—3 things we have heard and known, things our ancestors have told us.

Congregation: 4 We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done. 5 He decreed statutes for Jacob and established the law in Israel, which he commanded our ancestors to teach their children,

Leader: 6 so the next generation would know them, even the children yet to be born, and they in turn would tell their children. 7 Then they would put their trust in God and would not forget his deeds but would keep his commands.

ALL: 8 They would not be like their ancestors—a stubborn and rebellious generation, whose hearts were not loyal to God, whose spirits were not faithful to him. AMEN.



NOTES:

PASTOR: 1 Cor. 11:23 (KJV)

For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

1 Cor 11:24 (NLT) 24 and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”

Congregation: John 6:35 (KJV)

And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

PASTOR 1 Cor. 11:25 (KJV)

After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

Congregation: Hebrews 9:22 (KJV)

And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding blood is no remission.
