Sermon Title: Three Part Series - God. Family. Community.

Part Two: "FAMILY"

## Call To Worship

**Leader:** We say, "charity begins at home," and Scripture agrees. Family is where love, care, and faith start. Before we go out to serve the world, God calls us to show up at home—and when we do, choosing to serve the Lord with our households, we reflect His heart. *Gen 18:19; Joshua 24:15*

**Congregation:** God never designed faith to be hidden, especially within the family. Our faith is meant to be seen—modeled openly, beginning with those closest to us. Scripture tells us, "[we] are the light of the world ... let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." *Matt 5:14-16; Gen 18:19*

**ALL:** God cares deeply about the condition of our family relationships. We are not only called to seek reconciliation, but to remain committed to peace, forgiveness, and love, especially within the home. "Bear with one another and forgive one another... and over all these, put on love, which binds everything together in perfect unity." AMEN. *Col 3:13-14*

## Scripture Lesson: 1 Timothy 5:3-8 (NIV)

**Leader: 3** Give proper recognition to those widows who are really in need. **4** But if a widow has children or grandchildren, these should learn first of all to put their religion into practice by caring for their own family and so repaying their parents and grandparents, for this is pleasing to God.

**Congregation: 5** "The widow who is really in need and left all alone puts her hope in God and continues night and day to pray and to ask God for help. **6** But the widow who lives for pleasure is dead even while she lives.

**ALL: 7** Give the people these instructions, so that no one may be open to blame. **8** Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever. AMEN.
