Scripture Title: "GOD BLESS THE CHILD."

Call To Worship

Leader: God's blessing is far beyond making it through today—He provides wisdom and provision for us to build for tomorrow (sufficiency with purpose). "Go to the ant, ... consider its ways and be wise! ... it stores its provisions in summer and gathers its food at harvest." *Deut 8:18; Pro 6:6-8*

Congregation: God blesses us not by enabling dependency, but by building the capacity for us to mature and manage responsibility and challenge—through His strength. We are fed spiritually and transformed through His Word and empowered by His grace to live according to His purpose. *Heb 5:14; Phil 4:13; Rom 12:2*

ALL: God blesses us as His children when we faithfully steward what He places in our hands. Though our individual gifts—abilities, time, and opportunities—may differ, *all* of us has been given the capacity to love others without partiality. AMEN.

Scripture Lesson: Matthew 25: 14-18 & 24-29 (NIV)

Leader: 14 "Again, it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted his wealth to them. **15** To one he gave five bags of gold, to another two bags, and to another one bag, each according to his ability. Then he went on his journey.

Congregation: 16 The man who had received five bags of gold went at once and put his money to work and gained five bags more. **17** So also, the one with two bags of gold gained two more.

Leader: 18 But the man who had received one bag went off, dug a hole in the ground and hid his master's money. **24** "Then the man who had received one bag of gold came. 'Master,' he said, 'I knew that you are a hard man, harvesting where you have not sown and gathering where you have not scattered seed.

Congregation: 25 So I was afraid and went out and hid your gold in the ground. See, here is what belongs to you.' **26** "His master replied, 'You wicked, lazy servant! So you knew that I harvest where I have not sown and gather where I have not scattered seed?

Leader: 27 Well then, you should have put my money on deposit with the bankers, so that when I returned I would have received it back with interest. **28** "'So take the bag of gold from him and give it to the one who has ten bags.

ALL: 29 For whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. AMEN.
