Call To Worship

Leader: Scripture instructs us to “...not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.” As ambassadors of Christ, we are called to stand firm in our faith, boldly declaring God’s word without fear or compromise. *1 John 3:18; 2 Cor 5:20; 2 Tim 1:7*

Congregation: As we anchor ourselves in faith through our risen Savior, we grow to profoundly know our eternal security is in God only. “We are fearfully and wonderfully made” and empowered by the richness of God’s grace, love, and provisions.

John 10:28-29b, John 3:15-16, Eph 4:30, Jude 24

ALL: Regardless of the efforts of the world to deny the sovereignty and absolute power of God, no one can prevent what God has ordained. Jesus demonstrated this in the most radical way by His resurrection (victory over death, triumph of good over evil, and eternal life for all who believe and receive). AMEN. *Is 14:24, 26, 27; Psalm 139:14; Rom 10:9*

Scripture Lesson: Matthew 27: 57-66 (NIV)

Leader: 57 As evening approached, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. **58** Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus’ body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him.

Congregation: 59 Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, **60** and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of the rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away.

Leader: 61 Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were sitting there opposite the tomb. **62** The next day, the one after Preparation Day, the chief priests and the Pharisees went to Pilate.

Congregation: 63 “Sir,” they said, “we remember that while he was still alive that deceiver said, ‘After three days I will rise again.’

Leader: 64 So give the order for the tomb to be made secure until the third day. Otherwise, his disciples may come and steal the body and tell the people that he has been raised from the dead. This last deception will be worse than the first.”

ALL: 65 “Take a guard,” Pilate answered. “Go, make the tomb as secure as you know how.” **66** So they went and made the tomb secure by putting a seal on the stone and posting the guard.
