Call To Worship

Leader: Surrendering to Christ opens the way to victory over the flesh and aligns us with God's divine purpose. As we yield to Him, our priorities shift—we no longer live to please ourselves, but to honor God.

Gal 2:20; Rom 6:6–7; James 4:7

Congregation: "For it is by grace [we] have been saved, through faith—and this is not from [ourselves], it is the gift of God—not by works." Now covered by God's grace, we no longer work to earn His favor—we work because we belong to His kingdom.

Eph 2:8-10; Titus 3:5; 1 Cor 15:10

ALL: When Christ reigns at the center of our life, our lifestyle is no longer shaped by chaos or self-centeredness. It is transformed—anchored in peace, aligned with purpose, and led by the Holy Spirit.

Isa 26:3; Rom 8:14; Gal 5:25 AMEN.



Scripture Lesson: Galatians 2:15-20 (NIV)

Leader: 15 "We who are Jews by birth and not sinful Gentiles **16** know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified.

Congregation: 17 "But if, in seeking to be justified in Christ, we Jews find ourselves also among the sinners, doesn't that mean that Christ promotes sin? Absolutely not! **18** If I rebuild what I destroyed, then I really would be a lawbreaker.

ALL: 19 "For through the law I died to the law so that I might live for God. **20** I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. AMEN.

PASTOR: 1 Cor. 11:23 (KJV)

For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you,
That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took
bread:

1 Cor 11:24 (NLT) 24 and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”

Congregation: John 6:35 (KJV)

And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

PASTOR 1 Cor. 11:25 (KJV)

After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

Congregation: Hebrews 9:22 (KJV)
