Sermon Title:

"HALLELUJAH HOPE."

Call To Worship

Leader: As our Heavenly Father proves Himself faithful—keeping every promise, delivering His people, and healing the deepest places of our soul—we are reminded that He is the One from whom Hallelujah Hope flows. *2 Cor 1:20; Ps 34:17-18; Heb 10:23; Rom 15:13*

Congregation: Jesus is the reason for hope in every season of our life. He is our living hope, our Redeemer, and the fulfillment of every promise. Today let us praise God in advance of our breakthrough, trusting His faithfulness even when the outcome is not yet visible. *1 Pet 1:3; Rom 15:13; 5:5; Heb 6:19*

ALL: Our Helper in hope is God the Holy Spirit—He fills, strengthens, and sustains the hope placed within us. By His power, our hope is not only received but renewed, not only believed but lived. He is the One who empowers us to abound in hope beyond our own strength. *Hallelujah! Rom 15:13; Gal 5:22; John 14:26 AMEN.*



Scripture Lesson: Romans 15:8-13 (NIV)

Leader: **8** For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's truth, so that the promises made to the patriarchs might be confirmed **9** and, moreover, that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy. As it is written: "Therefore I will praise you among the Gentiles; I will sing the praises of your name."

Congregation: **10** Again, it says, "Rejoice, you Gentiles, with his people." **11** And again, "Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles; let all the peoples extol him."

Leader: **12** And again, Isaiah says, "The Root of Jesse will spring up, one who will arise to rule over the nations; in him the Gentiles will hope."

ALL: **13** May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. *AMEN.*
