# Call To Worship

Leader: While people in general are natural observers and learn best by watching, children are more susceptible and influenced by the actions and behaviors of parents, friends and others around them. As we live out our faith daily, scripture encourages us to "Impress [God's commandments] on [our] children." Let us take advantage of the opportunity to provide early spiritual training. Deut 6:6-7; Titus 2:7; Phil 4:9; Proverbs 22:6

Congregation: A loving parent corrects their child to help them grow by nurturing with love, guidance, and godly wisdom - shaping them into individuals who live with purpose and faith. Likewise, as children of God, we should take heed and embrace God's correction and not grow bitter but accept that it is essential for our spiritual growth.

Eph 6:4; Proverbs 3:11-12; Jer 29:11

ALL: As we manage the awesome responsibilities that come with parenting, we must discipline with purpose and ensure any correction is rooted in love, not frustration or anger. Let us preserve through any unpleasantness that comes from disciplining as it will eventually "produce a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it. AMEN. " Eph 6:4; Heb 12:11; Eph 4:15

### Scripture Lesson: 2 Samuel 18:1-5 (NIV)

Leader: 1 David mustered the men who were with him and appointed over them commanders of thousands and commanders of hundreds. 2 David sent out his troops, a third under the command of Joab, a third under Joab's brother Abishai son of Zeruiah, and a third under Ittai the Gittite. The king told the troops, "I myself will surely march out with you."

Congregation: 3 But the men said, "You must not go out; if we are forced to flee, they won't care about us. Even if half of us die, they won't care; but you are worth ten thousand of us. It would be better now for you to give us support from the city."

Leader: 4 The king answered, "I will do whatever seems best to you." So the king stood beside the gate while all his men marched out in units of hundreds and of thousands.

ALL: 5 The king commanded Joab, Abishai and Ittai, "Be gentle with the young man Absalom for my sake." And all the troops heard the king giving orders concerning Absalom to each of the commanders. AMEN.
